November 2007 report of the ASGS Canadian section to the BOD.

This year again the Canadian Section held only one section meeting, so far no one offered to host a fall meeting.

- In spring, the Canadian section held a very well attended meeting at McGill University.
- 26 glassblowers attended and participated in various activities.

A new slate of section officers was elected after acclamation. Their 2 year term will end in May 2009.

The new section treasurer, Brian Power, completed successfully the transfer of the section funds since Darcey Doering resigned after many years as a dedicated section treasurer.

After a very profitable meeting in spring that enriched the section by more than \$800.00 our finances are very good with no expenses and a balance of \$3185.37

It seems that there is a consensus among us that the proposition of Jack Korfhage who as far as we have heard was going to come up with a motion to propose hiring a professional team of symposium organisers would be a very good idea and would greatly simplify the organising of future symposiums when the section is too scattered or doesn't have enough members to assume such a task.

Should that motion pass, the Canadian section would be ready to help the special team organize a Canadian symposium and participate in any way that would be possible and chair the appropriate sections.
