Greetings from the Southwest Section

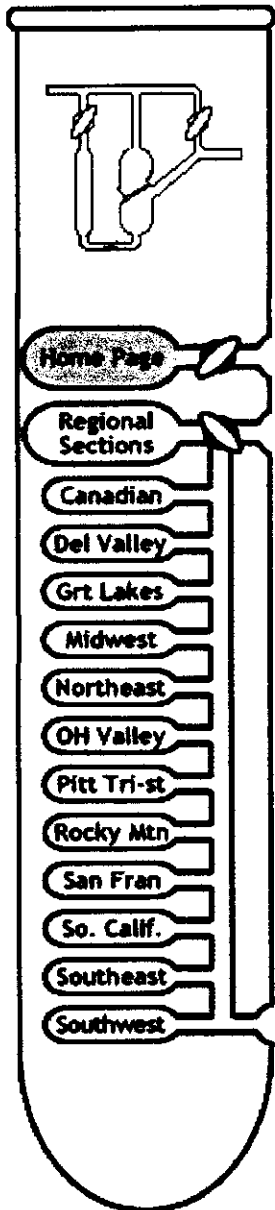
