Subject: November 2000 BOD Report of the ASGS Canadian Section,

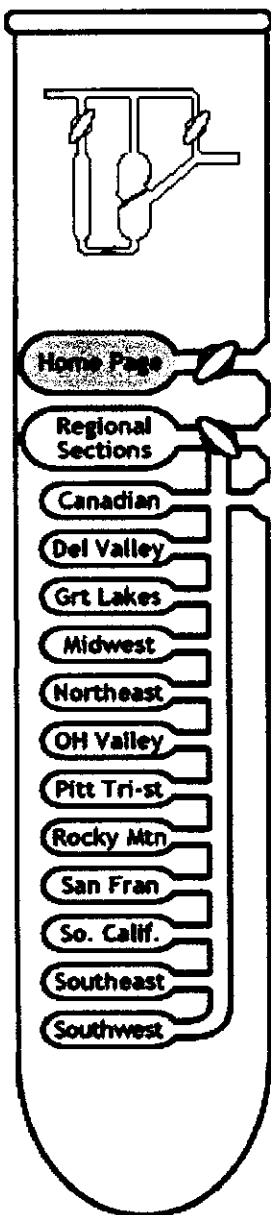
